Dear Brethren:

We face difficult, hard and uncertain times. For the first time in history the entire world is stopping its machines and confining millions of people in their homes. It is the only way Humanity can help our health systems, overwhelmed by the challenge, to defeat the Covid-19 virus.

As the pandemic progresses Masonic activity in all Grand Lodges in Harmony has been suspended. Our fraternal embraces, our signs and tokens, our festive boards, our sincere brotherhood, which we express every time we meet, would be part of the problem today. But as Masons, today confident in the peace of our homes with our loved ones, we will always be part of the solution.

I want to express my deep regret for the news that is coming to this Grand Mastership. There are brothers of the Grand Lodge of Spain who are currently fighting heroically, without all the instruments they would like, against this terrible pandemic - in hospitals, in police stations, in military premises, in supermarkets, in transportation and in other essential positions in society. And there are others who also fight the pandemic from a bed, suffering from the most severe symptoms of this disease.

There are no precedents for what we are living through or for what we will have to live through in the coming weeks. The experts, some of them brothers in our Order, say that for Spain the worst is yet to come.
